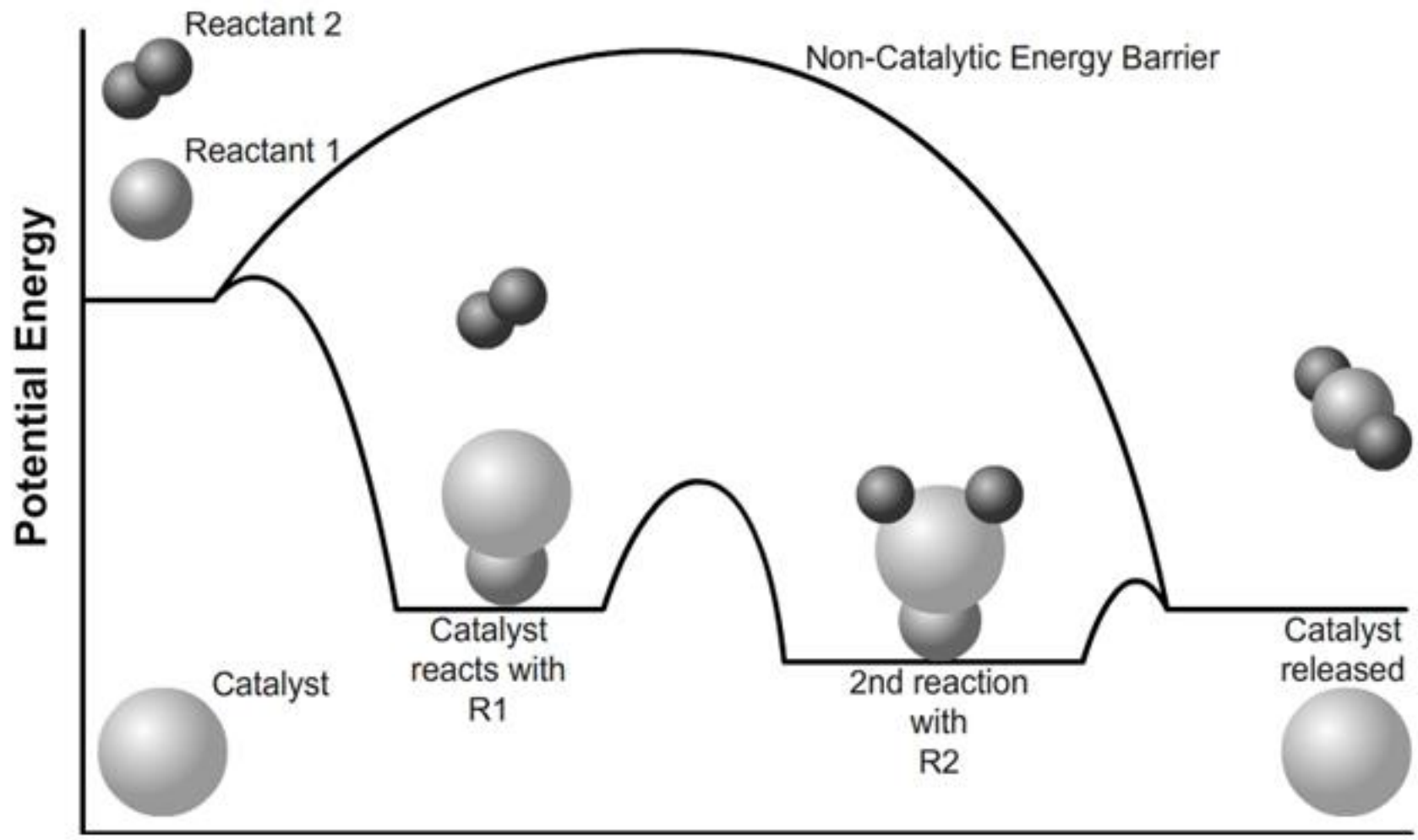

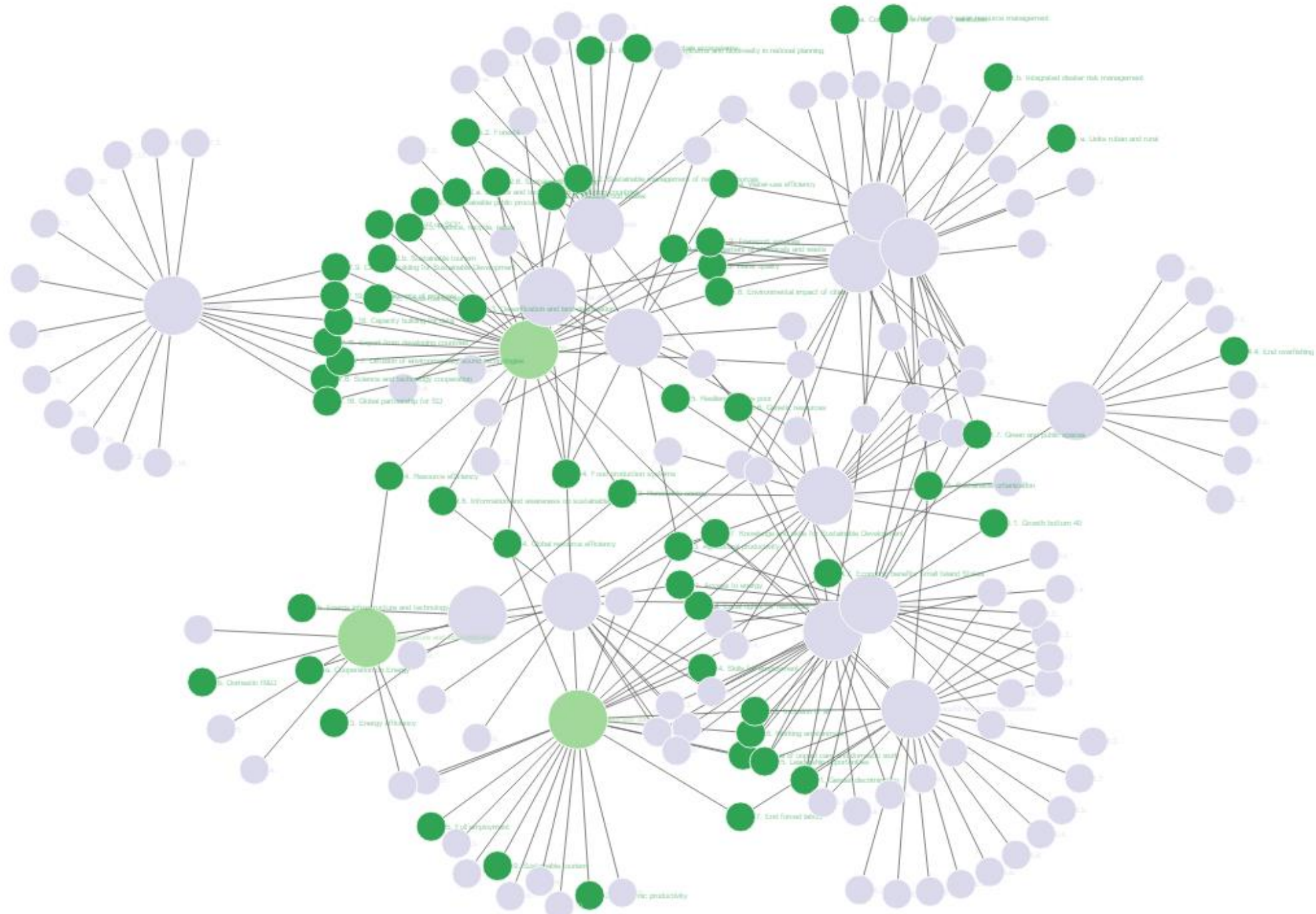
UNDP Catalytic and Scaling-up Facility

- Top-down way to Green Economy
 - possibilities for green employment
 - Integration of sustainable development objectives plans, budget, M&E
 - support nationalization and implementation Green Economy elements of the SDG framework
- Bottom-up way to Green Economy
 - including value chain analysis
 - new productive capacities business ideas
 - testing new low-cost or user-led technology
 - focus on productive sectors and/or with a specific focus on women's economic empowerment
